



WARNINGS


Units can tip or strike you.




•Do not open more than one loaded drawer at a time. •Keep children away.









Tipping of storage unit or unit striking you can cause injury.



Unit's edges can cut or pinch. •Do not pull; push to move.

•Wear gloves when lifting by edges.

- 460mm (18 inches) or more above the floor.
